

FOURTEENTH ANNUAL REPORT & FINANCIAL STATEMENT

On behalf of the Committee of S.P.C. Cricket Club, I present the 14th Annual Report & Financial Statement for season 80/81.



SECRETARY

S.P.C. once again fielded three senior teams in the Matting Section, being "A", "C", & "E" grades in E.S.C.A. Following on from last season, the Club again had two finalists being the "A" & "E" grade sides. The 3rd Eleven won the premiership & the 1st Eleven were runners-up. Unfortunately, the 2nd Eleven finished with the wooden spoon, but I'm sure as many others do they'll reverse that position next season.

There were many fine performances during the season as the following summaries will show.

1ST XI

Once again the team was led by Peter Sandilands, with the Firsts winning 10, losing 3 and draws 1. Finishing 2nd at the end of the home and home games, the side were set to do well in the finals. However, that elusive flag was not to be ours.

faulted to the pressure inflicted by our bowlers, being all out for 178. Greg Wignell took 7/88 in a great spell with Bryan Cain and Peter Ormond 1 wicket a piece.

In the final, we met A.Y.C. who were the only team that defeated us during the season. Losing the toss we were sent in to bat and were in trouble early and never really recovered to be all out for 241 - top scorers were Kevin Burt 72, Greg Wignell 50 and John Krohn 29. A.Y.C. took control of the game when many catches were put down and finished winning the game with a score of 8/395. Best bowlers were Greg Wignell, Peter Ormond and Bryan Cain who captured 2 wickets a piece.

This season as in the last, we've got the ability to be a top side but just a bit more application is required to be the best side in "A" Grade.

2nd XI

Led by Bernie Brell, the Seconds had a disappointing season with nil wins, 1 tie, 1 draw and 10 losses. Finishing last, the team never really showed the ability they can produce, but with some 34 players having a game during the season, it was hard to have a strong moulded side.
