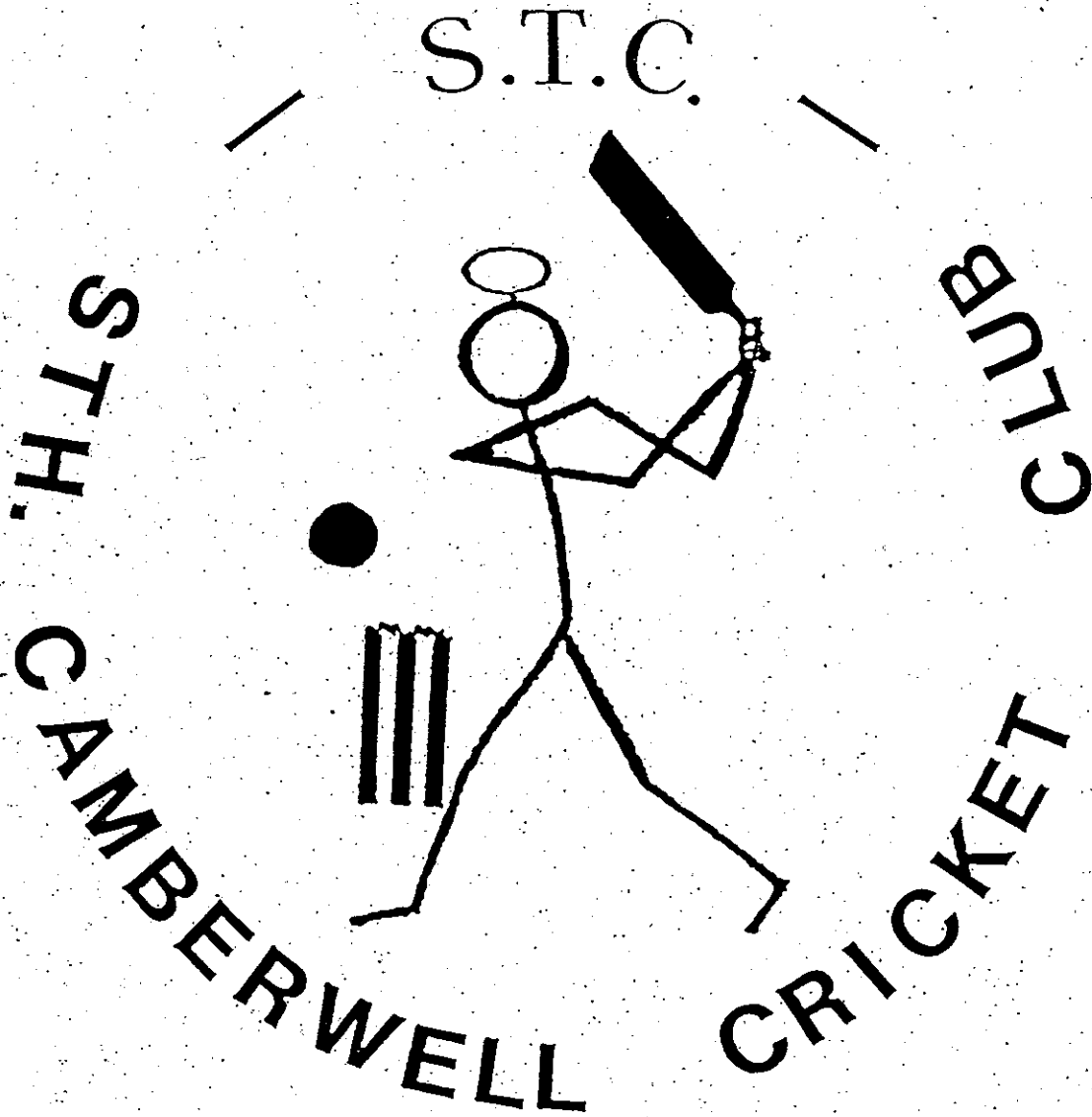

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

FIRST XI REPORT

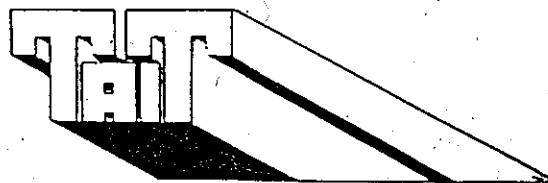
