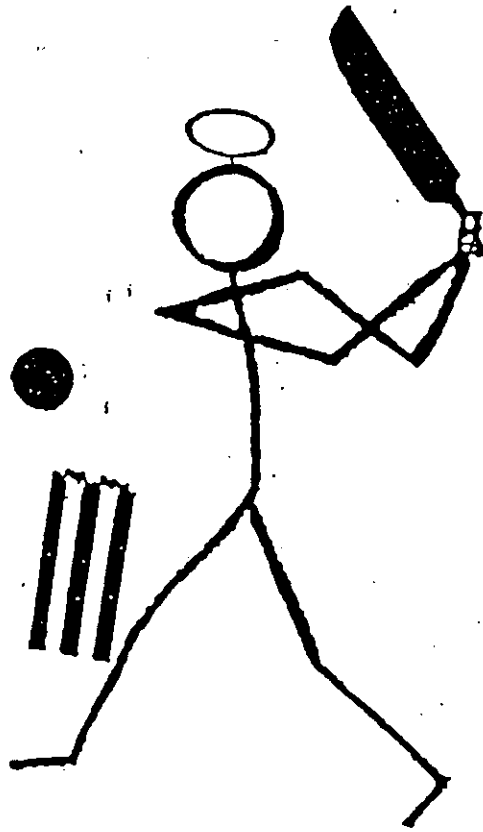

## SECOND ELEVEN

Despite missing our ultimate goal of making the finals, I believe we made progress in the two's this year. I say this because (i) the standard of the competition was higher following the demotion of several of last season's A Grade sides, and (ii) we were right in contention for a play-off berth until the second last game of the season. From a team perspective, we soundly beat Bulleen (down from A Grade), we also beat old rivals Box Hill South for the first time in many years, and handed out hidings to Balwyn, Riversdale, & Aswood. Individual highlights for the season were:-

**Kevin Burt**, who in his only game scored a magnificent 81.

**Tim Allen**, for his "Fred Flintstone" catch at Balwyn, and his usual tidy work.

**Mick Burslem**, played several timely knocks, and provided timely advice to Barrel.

**Anthony Purcell**, who showed lots of potential and a little actual as an off spinner and tonker, a front foot pull shot against Mt Waverley the highlight.

**Stuart McCulloch**, who batted well and always "produced" when given the ball.

The season began with a draw and four losses despite putting ourselves in good positions in games against Mont Albert (4/24 chasing our 127) and Mulgrave (5/68). Our highlight was a brilliant win over West Hawthorn (230) in Round 7 where a great team batting effort (5 scores over 28, Ranj Singh 58 n.o.) by a young team saw us snatch a last over win by 2 runs (9/232) with Ranj hitting a match winning six off the second last ball. Round 8 saw Leigh Jondahl take 7/65 off 18 overs to put us in a winning position against Mulgrave only to see our batsmen let ourselves down (120) despite Ranj's immortal 70. An outright (STC 3/306, Tracey 101 no, S. McCarthy 92, A. Curry 56) over a depleted Kew Deaf (33, 92) saw the return of Tim Finnigan (5/5 & 5/50) in a big performance for the club. One of the disappointments was the narrow loss to the eventual premiers Marcellin after a good batting performance (STC 7/248, K. Lynch 80 no, Finnigan 53, Spithill 42) only to see them bat to 9/249, winning off the last ball!! Tim Finnigan bowled a gutsy 37 overs for 7/82 doing all a captain could ask of him.

My special thanks to all the juniors who were there when the club needed them; we have some fine young cricketers. Thanks to Leigh, Tim, Nathan & Phil for their bowling efforts; Ranj for his all round achievements, enthusiasm and a great win; Kev Lynch for his batting (av 35) and Andy, Leigh & Tim for supporting me. Congratulations to Kev for his batting honour, Leigh for the bowling (18 wickets @ 11.27), Ranj for the team trophy (9 wickets @ 28.6 and av. 39.2) and Tim for his all round effort (23 wickets @ 12.39 and av 37).

Overall, a Coodabeen year where we let ourselves down by not taking full advantage of winning positions. Two wins for an STC team is not good enough and we must take the responsibility to aim higher. The plans have been laid for the assault in 95/96. I invite the team to improve on our fielding and batting, support each other and take the next step to reach our full potential.
