## junior co-ordinator's report

It was a great pleasure in 2000/01 to see the increased level of commitment and contribution through the Club to the welfare of our younger players. I was very happy that so many of our junior players made significant improvement in their skill levels from the previous season, reflected in the competitive performance of all our teams. The Club also took an important step in establishing a pre-Under 12s clinic, taking part in the VCA's Milo Have A Go program for the first time, under the management of Steve Ross.

We entered two teams in Under 12s, one in Under 14s and one in Under 16s. All four sides finished around the middle of their respective ladders, with both the U16s and U14s chances to contest the finals with a couple of games to go. The U16s produced a sensational win over the top side and went into the final round believing they had finished in fourth place, only to discover that the ladder situation changed during the final round when an outstanding match report from before Christmas was finally submitted to the grade secretary. We hope that the Association will take a sterner approach to sloppy management of junior teams in future, to ensure such disappointments cannot occur again.

Graham Johnston managed the Under 16s admirably, handling the move up from U14s Manager in the previous season with ease. The boys performed a little unevenly during a season disrupted by limited training support and more than our fair share of byes, walkovers and washouts. Several players who completed their junior apprenticeship will be warmly welcomed into senior ranks in 2001/01; a couple like Peter Morrison and Peter Mercoulia have already shown that they are ready for that next step.

The Under 14s showed great promise, with many of the boys in their first season out of Under 12s. Several new recruits boosted the side, which Dan Muling managed, with my help when Dan's judicial duties kept him from attending games on Friday evenings. After some excellent early season form, the team slipped a little against a couple of strong teams, showing the importance of playing straight when batting and holding catches in the field. David Elliott matured rapidly as captain, and Will Smith's skills were rewarded with selection in the SECA representative team which was undefeated in its carnival matches until the semi-final.

The Under 12 Reds were managed enthusiastically by Tom Keel, helped early in the season by Matt Funnell and after Christmas by Mt Martha commuter Basil Finnigan. Having recovered from his second knee replacement during the winter of 2000, Basil took over U12 coaching duties from January and earned the same respect from this year's boys as he has during some twenty years of involvement with STC junior cricketers. Both Under 12 sides struggled for numbers at times, with 25 players on the list by the end of the season, but sometimes only eighteen available to be split between the two sides. All the same, the Reds finished fifth on their ladder with ?? points, and were only narrowly beaten in several exciting finishes. The Blues, after winning just one game in 1999/2000, showed tremendous improvement and teamwork, with new recruits welcomed by the core of veterans with a season's experience under their belts. The Blues finished in fourth place with twelve wins and a washout from eighteen rounds. The team gave several boys their first taste of competitive sport, and the improvement from week to week and the steady development of a genuine team spirit demonstrated clearly the benefits of commitment to a team sport.

Milo clinics were run on Sunday mornings, with a dozen or more youngsters enjoying the chance to improve their skills and taking great pleasure in the games that always wound up the session. February saw the annual parents and sons games, with the U12Reds taking on the Blues and the U14s and U16s combining to tackle the parents. The Junior Presentation Night in March was extremely well attended by the boys and their families and allowed all the players to celebrate the success of participating, as well as recognising the special efforts of the trophy-winners.

Special thanks are due to all the managers, Committee members (especially Peter Lynch), senior players who helped with the special events as well as those who turned up on dewy Saturday mornings when rostered, and the parents who helped with transport, scoring, the canteen and the dozens of other tasks that go with junior sport.

Congratulations to Mrs Carol Williams, winner of the inaugural Best Junior Clubperson trophy, and both the Club's and my personal thanks to local State MP Mr Bob Stensholt who donated the trophy, as well as supporting the Club's ultimately successful application for grant funds towards improved safety equipment for the juniors. I look forward to all the boys coming back and building on their skills in season 2000/01, and an even better commitment from the senior part of the Club to the juniors who represent the long-term future of STC.

## fourth XI report

## club XI report
