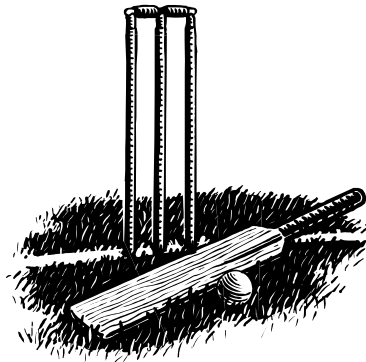
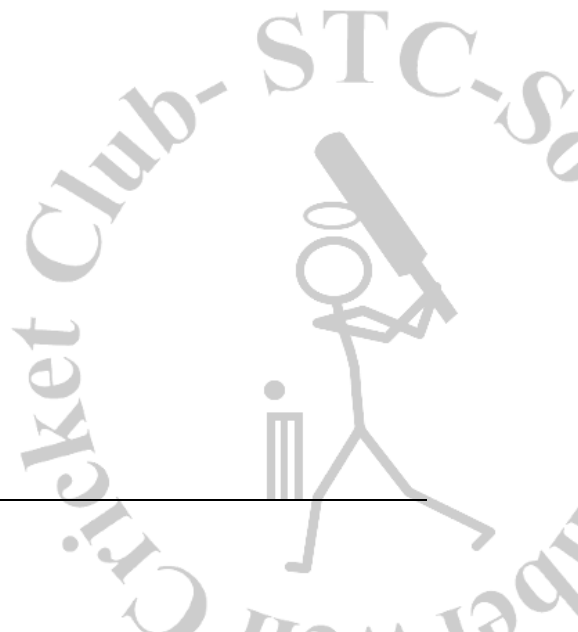
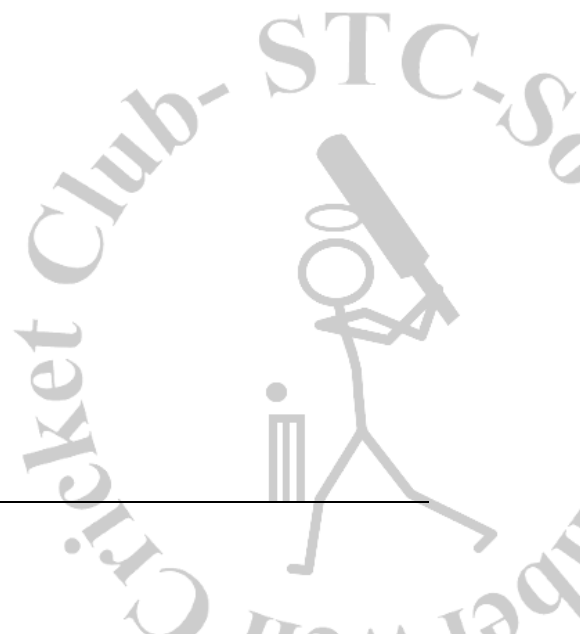

Vale Joe Cain

When, in 1967, the famous conversation took place over the side fence of neighbouring properties in Valley Parade, leading to the establishment of STC South Camberwell Cricket Club, Joe Cain was already an established identity in St Cecilia's Parish and in the broader neighbourhood. He and his family lived just one street north of Valley Parade, in Malvern Avenue. His Hartwell-based real estate business had been operating for almost twenty years. His children had attended the church primary school. And he had a long and proud sporting record when, in his early fifties, he first pulled on his whites for the fledgling parish cricket club.

Joe wasn't able to play in the club's inaugural fixture, an outright defeat by Willison Park, but made his debut in the second round, contributing 79 to a solid victory. He went on to play 21 matches in the club's first two seasons, making over 800 runs at better than 38, with a top score of 93. He also picked up 34 wickets at less than 15, with best figures of 4/7, and in between times took eight catches. Not bad for a bloke in his sixth decade.

The club history records that the First (and only) XI, having gone down honourably in a B grade semi final in its first season, was promoted to A grade, starting the second season in the same way as we had started our first, by being beaten comprehensively outright. The competitive spirit of Joe and other founding members came to the fore, however, and STC reached the finals, winning the semi against Park Orchards. Joe led the attack, taking 4/32 as Park Orchards were bowled out for 162, then top-scored with 61 in the STC reply of 211. There's a strong indication that Joe was one who rose to the occasion in big matches.

In the final against Boroondara our batting collapsed in the first innings for just 114, then John Aspinall and Peter Sandilands smashed the opposition for 45 in 25 spectacular overs. Along with Kevin Burt's 52, Joe's 40 provided the spine of STC's second innings effort of 184. Boroondara also fought back in the second innings, but despite making the highest score of the game with 223, fell 33 runs short as STC claimed its first premiership. Joe took 4/38 in that innings, and had the honour of taking the tenth wicket that unleashed the celebrations. Joe also had the rare privilege of sharing that premiership success with his son Michael as a team-mate (as did Alan and Kevin Burt).

Although Joe didn't play for the club again, the Cain name was carried on with great distinction by Michael and later Bryan, each of whom played excellent First XI cricket over several seasons. Joe took great pride in recent years over his grandson Brendan, Bryan's son, starting a junior cricket career at STC.

Joe was also a very important contributor off the field. He was one of the club's foundation Vice Presidents, along with Jack Dwyer and Gerry Mazoletti (who passed away late last year). And when the Club found itself in need of funds as it expanded both its junior and senior programs, and looked around for sponsors, JA Cain and Co was one of the first to be approached, and consistently one of the most generous supporters. The first formal acknowledgement of JA Cain and Co's formal sponsorship appears in the 1984-85 Annual Report, and the company's direct financial support of STC has continued uninterrupted for the ensuing two

decades. Joe's instigation of that support, in collaboration with Bryan, was recognised at the Club's 25th Season dinner in 1991 with the award of Life Membership.

Joe is now the first of our Life Members to have passed away. His strong sense of family, of community and of sportsmanship, which he shared with other founding members, were instilled into the fabric of the club in its formative years, and have remained with us ever since. The club has grown in size and in on-field success, and has become a power in the synthetic section of the Association, and Joe would have just cause to be proud of the strength of the club that he helped to nurture. But he would be just as proud that the club has retained its commitment to those original principles that he held dear throughout his life. The duty remains with us to ensure that we never lose sight of those fundamentals.

STC Cricket Club remembers Joe Cain, Life Member, fondly and gratefully, and extends its heartfelt sympathy to Joe's widow, Neva, his children including fellow STC players Michael and Bryan, his many grandchildren and great-grandchildren and all his friends. May he rest in peace.

Vale Gerry Mazoletti

A strong clubman, Gerry was Vice President in STC's founding year and later held the post of President for three years between 1968 & 1971. His son Brian, who will be known to many STC players from the late 70s through to the early 90s, represented Gerry on the field and was a member of the Club's 1980-81 Third XI premiership side. From all reports, Gerry was a meticulous and well organized man, who valued his involvement with the club highly.

A great supporter of our club for many years, Gerry often made his Lomond Street home available for club functions. In the later years of his life, in catching up with friends such as John Mahoney, Gerry would often ask about the Club's fortunes and recount stories from the early years.

Gerry was also an active member of the St Cecilia's tennis club, often inviting STC people down to his holiday home at Mt Martha for a bit of a hit on their own private tennis court.

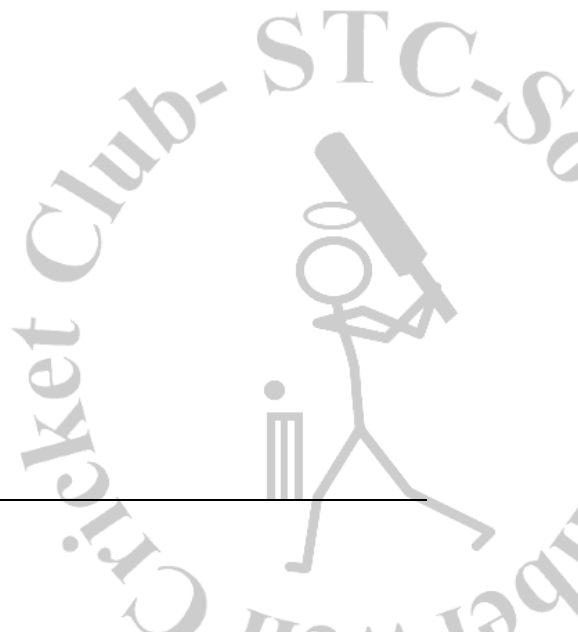
Gerry's wife Eileen expressed much appreciation to the STC community for attending the funeral of her husband.

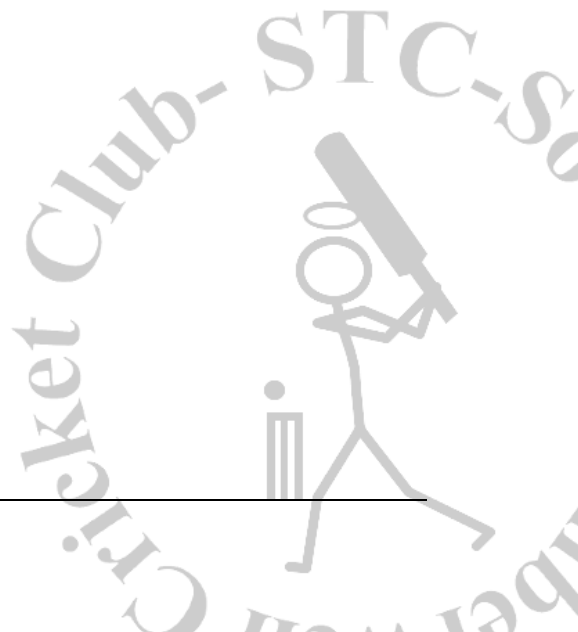

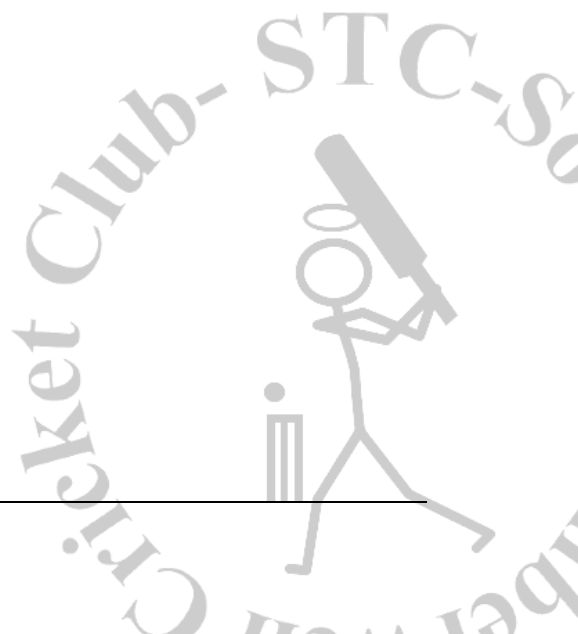

Presidents Report

Season 2005/06 was a year of mixed success for our club. What was achieved off the field was exceptional, while our junior club was also very successful winning two premierships. Unfortunately, on the field, the senior club finished the year without the results that we had expected.

The committee was magnificent this season, and we certainly delivered on our promises. I would like to thank the entire committee for their dedication throughout the year. Every committee member had a specific area of responsibility, and had to take ownership of any problems that they confronted. It was a pleasure to work with each and every committee member and it was especially rewarding to observe the entire committee working as a team. I would like to give a special thank you to Peter Lynch in his role as Senior Vice-President. Lynchy is incredibly reliable and efficient, and has been a brilliant support to me this season.

The committee set some measurable goals at the beginning of the year, and communicated them to all members of the club. Two of our goals were put in place to ensure that the immediate to long-term future of our club was as strong as possible. One goal was to have more than 300 recognised members of our club. I can report that through the hard work of our committee, we have 547 members - made up of life members, senior players, junior players and social members. I would like to thank our club secretary, Kylie Zennaro, for her fantastic efforts in this area, and her wonderful contribution throughout the season.

Another goal was to record a profit in excess of \$5000. This was a real challenge because of the high costs associated with running our club. However, through the hard work of our committee, we were able to generate enough income from social functions, sponsorships and other grants, to ensure that we achieved this goal. Our treasurer's report is attached to the Annual report. I would like to thank Treasurer Ed Behan for the work he did to ensure that we were able to achieve a record profit this season.

Our last goal was to win two premierships. Whilst we did not win any senior premierships, we did manage two brilliant junior premierships. This was a great effort, as our Under 14's did not lose a game for the entire season, while our Under 12's won the Mitchell Shield – the top level of U.12 cricket in the ECA.

The juniors were magnificent this season and you can read all of the highlights in Stuart Hamilton's report. Stuart has been an outstanding in his role as Junior Vice-President, and the success of our juniors this season is a reflection of his hard work and commitment. Thanks also to Basil Finnigan, who never fails to inspire us, for his untiring support of our junior cricketers. As is often stated, the juniors are the future of our club and it is up to each and every senior player to support our junior program. I would like to thank Jack Krohn, Steve Ross and Peter Morrison, all of whom contributed greatly to our junior club while maintaining a playing role with the senior club. A junior committee will be established for the coming season, with a major focus being to generate a great deal more senior support at junior training and games.

Other committee highlights for the season include arranging the upgrade of our training nets (through obtaining a grant that was available through the Nettleton Park sub committee), attracting new sponsors, increasing our social receipts, streamlining many of our committee processes, and working as a team to manage the day to day operations of our great club. The committee recognise that there is further room for improvement in the coming season, and look forward to the challenge of building on our performance of this season.

On two occasions this season, the entire club wore black armbands as a mark of respect for two club members who have both played a major role in our clubs history. Life Member and long time sponsor, Joe Cain, and former President, Gerry Mazoletti, both passed away through the season. It was fantastic to witness the support that our community was able to give to the Cain and Mazoletti families during their time of mourning.

The senior club were very competitive this season, but probably produced results that were a little below our potential. Our recent on-field success has meant that we have high expectations. However, it must be realised that our recent success is no longer all that recent. We cannot hang our hats on our performances of yesteryear! As a club, we know that we face a challenge on the eve of our 40th anniversary. We will not leave any stone unturned in our quest to return to the top. Player recruitment and a revitalised training program will be major priorities for the club in season 2006/07.

Inappropriate on field behaviour was an issue for the club again this year. A sub committee is being formed to create a code of behaviour that all players will have to abide by in the future. This has been an ongoing problem, and the club is suffering because of it. I hope that a player's code of conduct will solve this problem. It is the responsibility of each and every Club member to uphold the reputation of the Club at all times both on and off the field.

I would like to thank all of our generous sponsors who are listed in this report. Their contribution is vital to our club's success and I urge all club members to support these local businesses whenever possible.

Without naming them, I would like to thank all of the reliable club members who continually help around the club - they are the heart and soul of amateur sports clubs. The work that volunteers undertake to assist the committee is an essential ingredient in our club's success, and their efforts are greatly appreciated.

I would also like to thank the player's partners and families for always being so willing to support our cricketing efforts! Your contributions help make STC the wonderful place it is.

We have a great club, and we need to enjoy the opportunities and friendships it provides. However, the challenge is ahead of us, and we must rejuvenate the saints and get back on top where we belong.

The planning for next season has already begun. The main ingredient in any rebuild is the commitment to hard work and the quality of the people involved. We have the resources – the hard work is all that it will take.

Next season we will return to celebrate our 40th birthday in style.

First XI Report

Firstly I'd like to thank all 20 players who represented the 1st XI in season 2005/06. All 20 players played their part in the firsts reaching their 5th consecutive finals series. Special mention must go to Pete Mercoulia and Andy Classon who made their 1st XI debuts this season versus Clifton Hill and Deepdene respectively.

After the disappointment of last season's grand final loss we looked to make amends and introduce some new initiatives. One of these initiatives was to form a training sub-committee to help provide the club with a training routine that best suits our clubs size and facilities, while also improving every player's cricket skills. As you would all have noticed there were some changes that were put in place, like the mobile net and concreting of the permanent nets. These changes along with many others were due to several meetings by our sub-committee in the pre-season and I thank Glenn Elliott, Andy Classon, James Hall and Danny Sotiriadis for all their help and thoughts with training throughout the season.

In a disruptive season where only 4 players played every game we were top of the ladder at Christmas, and had all but secured a finals berth. Our goal at this stage was to maintain top spot which would mean winning all four games. This would give us the best opportunity of playing a weaker opponent come finals time, as we felt the top 3 sides in Macgibbon, which of course included ourselves, were extremely even. Unfortunately we let ourselves down in the space of 45 minutes with some extremely poor batting, where we lost 5 wickets for a meagre 15 runs at the end of day one in round 12 versus Boroondara. We were unable to recover from the position the following week, losing the game and hence missing out on top spot by 3 points and finishing 3rd on percentage.

As we all know we were unable to make our 5th consecutive grand final, going down to Burwood in an intensely fought game where the boys never gave up, which was exemplified by two awesome catches by 12th man Andy Classon. We had our chances but unfortunately we didn't take them, which you can't get away with in finals.

Again this season our bowlers, lead by Rohan Worthy, who took a fabulous 35 wickets, were consistently good without being outstanding. Unfortunately as seems to be the case in past seasons our batting let us down with 2 batsmen scoring 39% of the entire runs for the side all season. A staggering stat which must be eradicated next season.

With change in the 1st XI next season there is a massive opportunity for many. Having participated in 4 grand finals and a semi in the last 5 seasons, it can be very easy for the side to become complacent and expect success. This season needs to be a lesson that we all need to work super hard next season to make sure that the club is still moving forward. I ask all players no matter what grade you have played in the past to strive to play in the ones. No spot is pigeon holed; there are opportunities for whoever wants to take them. The more players we have pushing for a spot in the 1st XI the stronger the side becomes as well as the rest of the club. Five years ago the plan was to become the Old Xaverians of the Amateurs or the Vermonts of Eastern footy. At this stage the base is there for us to become a powerhouse club, but everything we have achieved in the past five years will count for nothing if we are not prepared to do the hard work that all successful clubs do.

I'd like to congratulate Chris Classon on getting the thirds to the finals. After a slow start the 3's were able to find some form and did well to play finals. Clas must be congratulated on this achievement, especially after the thirds performances in the past few seasons.

Finally I'd like to thank my vice-captain Danny Sotiriadis, Danny was of great support both on and off the field throughout the season and did a hell of a lot more than was required of him. Thanks for your effort Danny – it is greatly appreciated.

Fourth XI Report

The Fourths eventually finished sixth on the ladder, a disappointing and unfulfilling result given the team's ability to be competitive with every other team in the grade. We had five wins (two of which were over a team that lost every game it played before withdrawing from the grade at the Christmas break), six losses and two draws. Among the losses were defeats by margins of two, three and fifteen runs and three wickets, so that with a little extra luck in a couple of those matches we could well have been contesting finals.

However, there is more than just luck to take into account when analyzing the outcome of a full season. We were found wanting in several areas, including commitment at training, pre-match preparation, ability to turn the scoreboard over even when the bowling was too good for us to dominate and ability to bowl consistently to a plan and to a field. There were few games in which we did not have good patches, and none in which we were not in a winning position at the half-way stage or later. But there were also few in which we did not let ourselves down at some stage, whether by dropping critical catches, bowling a string of loose overs or surrendering a few cheap wickets.

It is symbolic that perhaps our greatest achievement came in a game which we eventually lost. Having failed dismally with the bat when chasing a modest score in the one day fixture against Marcellin, we let ourselves down badly in the field in the two day return game at Nettleton. Our inability to bowl a steady length cost us severely, to the tune of 435 runs from 80 overs. Our reply with the bat was sensational, led by a wonderful maiden ton from Anthony Purcell, and valuable contributions from most of the other batsmen. Needing twelve to win from the final over, with the last pair at the crease, we managed nine from the first three balls, then lost our tenth wicket to a catch at point from the fourth to fall two agonizing runs short of Marcellin's total. We smashed the previous Fourth XI record highest score by 64 runs, yet still lost. To do better next season, we will need to make sure we perform well throughout games, not just for a single innings.

Among the individuals, Purce was a revelation at the top of the order, and thoroughly earned his promotion to the Thirds and then the Seconds, and his trophy for Most Improved Player at the club. In the season in which he played his 100th game, he surpassed his personal highest score prior to the season on three occasions, and his ton against Marcellin was a triumph of concentration and courage. Matt Swan was a great acquisition with his forceful batting, penetrating medium pacers and enthusiasm and athleticism in the field. His partnership of 97 with Dan "Basil" Smith at Heathmont set up a comfortable win from a precarious position at 5/67, and he made a great unbeaten ton at Markham Avenue against AYC, something many STC players would love to emulate. Michael Byrne toiled hard with the ball and although he can improve his accuracy and consistency, bowled with real hostile pace and aggression and made many vital breakthroughs for us. Morro, Loz Colman, Stirlo and Mitch were all hard workers with the ball and had their moments, although Mitch in particular was hard done by with many of our fielding lapses costing him hard-earned wickets. Andy Paraskevas, Muzz and Zed were among the more prominent contributors with the bat.

For the Fourth XI to do better next season, several things must happen. We need greater commitment through the senior club for players to play regularly, as unavailabilities in higher teams compounded the selection problems in the Fours. We need real dedication by all players to improve their cricket and aspire to earn places in the higher sides. All of us can do enough of the basics, but we have much room to improve on the little things. Our "walking in with the bowler" is an example of a part of the game that demands no skill whatsoever, just the willingness to walk in aggressively through the bowler's delivery and the batsman's stroke (that is, not strolling a couple of paces and stopping as the ball is delivered), then the willingness to return to the starting point and do it all again, and again, and again. It is easy, but few of us did it consistently. Without applying ourselves to improving in those "one percenter" areas, we cannot expect the fruits of success to drop into our laps. But I believe there is the will to improve, and I look forward to being a part of a significantly better Fourth XI effort and performance in 2006-07.

Fifth XI Report

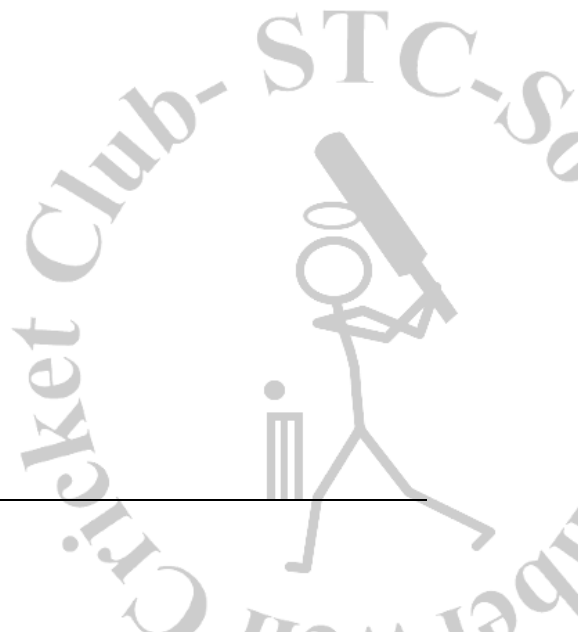
