Presidents Report

What an amazing season we had in 2012/13, winning a total of 4 premierships, and reminding all other clubs that we are a powerhouse in the synthetic grade of the ECA! The premierships included two in the senior competition, with our First XI going back to back in the top grade for the first time. Our C grade team is also the first non-1st XI premiership in some ten seasons. Well done to our premiership captains, Luke D'Astoli and Adam Burt, as well as all of their players. Our junior program saw unprecedented success, with a record 8 teams, all four of our U/14 and U/16 sides making the finals, with the U/16B side winning the grand final, and our U/12B undefeated on top and taking out the premiership.

We saw a wave of new players at the club, with several debutants in the 1st XI, and numerous others playing their first full seasons for the club. The committee embarked on a recruiting drive in the pre-season, and the success of this was evident with 4 new players being a part of the successful senior premiership sides.

Off the field, the club had one of the strongest and most enjoyable social calendars of any club in the ECA. The Melbourne Cup Day function saw over 60 people attend Nettleton Park on Cup Day, an event which will hopefully become a staple of the STC Social Calendar. The Day at the Sandown Dogs function was again a great success, and an easy money maker for the club. We had a much more successful Christmas Party than the year before, and our Basil Finnegan Medal which we combined with a past players night packed everyone into Nettleton Park to see Sam Fairbrother win his first Basil Finnegan Medal. We also celebrated the end of the season with our presentation night at Merrimu Receptions, with over 90 people in attendance, who all saw Steve Ross become the 24th Life Member of the club, congratulations Kerners!

The continued development of our younger players at the club has been really great to see, from the current U16s like Harry Douglas and Xavier Wigg making runs and taking wickets in the 3s and 4s, to the performances of Alex Brebner-Griffin, Matt Thomas and Matt Doran in the 1s and 2s. The club has a very promising future.

The club has faced a significant increase in costs in recent years, which had the potential to impact on the clubs finances unless we took a prudent approach to the management of our costs and revenues. Our ground tenancy went up significantly, and council are now charging us utilities under a draconian system of cost allocation. However, we have managed to cover these cost increases, and turned a significant loss from last season, into a strong, healthy profit for 2012/13.

I would like to thank all of those on the committee this season for their help and assistance, particularly those on the Executive. Beau Coyle, Tim Sharpe and Matthew Francis were all first time Executive members, and they should all be proud of their efforts during the year. There were times this season when the committee wasn't operating as effectively as it could have. In that regard, it is important that those who nominate for, and accept committee positions are committed to doing the job that is required of them, otherwise it places significant pressure on others to pick up the slack.

I would also like to thank all of our club sponsors for their financial support, particularly JA Cain, Bendigo Bank and Behan & Behan. It would be remiss of me not to also thank the tireless work done by Brad Craine our Chairman of Selectors, as well as Jack Krohn who deputised whilst Brad was away. Whilst we again struggled for numbers at times during the season, we managed to keep our 5th XI and played every game without one forfeit. With a continued focus on recruiting, I believe we will be able to maintain the 5th XI which is in the best interests of the club.

After four years on the Executive, I will be standing down from all committee positions for the time being, to spend more time at home with Lisa and Oscar. I have thoroughly enjoyed my time in both the Treasurer and Presidents role, and I firmly believe the club is in a very strong position both on and off-field.

<u>First XI Report</u>

Despite the threat of a premiership hangover, a poor pre-season, the disruption that came with 21 different players playing during the season and strong opposition from a hungry Boroondara and accomplished new side Edinburgh, the STC First XI achieved what it had never done before and secured back to back MacGibbon Shields!

That we did this was a tribute to the desire to consistently perform at our best regardless of the opposition, which meant that our grand final win capped a 14 game winning streak after losing a lone game in round one against Deepdene.

We proved yet again that when placed under pressure we have the resolve to perform at our best and come up trumps. A slow start from run machine Steve O'Connell meant that our batsmen had the opportunity to step up and make match winning contributions which they did as we had seven players score over 200 runs for the season.

From a team perspective our highlights included:

- Attempting three outright victories against the bottom three sides. We came up just short each time but it's a good problem to have.
- Our grand final replay against Boroondara in round 4 where Lawrence Colman led the attack as we rolled them for 131. In reply we were in a huge amount of trouble at 3/10 which brought together Dan O'Connell (59) and Sam Fairbrother (72) who launched a stunning counter attack and destroyed the Boroondara bowling line up, highlighted by Fairy hitting three consecutive 6s onto the Ashburton pools rooftop. We secured victory in just the 17th over of the innings.
- Our first ever match against Edinburgh at the sandpit that was Peterson Oval was a classic. Coming into the game without Colman and Adam D'Addazio we won the toss and batted, making 148 on an extremely slow outfield. Bowling in 35+ degree heat, the bowlers toiled away with Edinburgh reaching 2/81 before a stunning collapse was triggered by Luke D'Astoli (5/36) and Rohan Worthy (3/23). An astonishing change of weather conditions saw the bowlers having to battle gale force winds as Edinburgh closed in on the total before we eventually secured a 3 run victory, triggering jubilant celebrations.
- The final round of the season against Clifton Hill and their tear away quick Dalis Thomas saw Sam Fairbrother captain the side for the first time in my absence. As the team fell to 5/148 on the lightning fast Warner Reserve, the stand in captain (102) was joined by Tom Casha (115) and the pair stood up under pressure to record a 191 run partnership as they steered the side to safety in emphatic style.
- The finals campaign featured an extraordinary match against Edinburgh as Steve O'Connell (125) struck top form at the right time with a masterful century that formed the backbone of our innings. He was well supported by Tom Bach (65) and Fairy who played another brutal hand, striking 91 of just 64 balls in a game breaking innings. Defending 365 was no fait accompli as we bowled at Warner with temperatures hovering around 40 degrees against a strong batting line up. A disciplined effort saw us come up trumps by 20 runs in a tense contest.
- The grand final saw us lose the toss and asked to bowl on a day that would see rain interrupt once before ending the day 90 minutes early. We bowled with tremendous discipline on day one, keeping the run scoring down and removing the three key wickets leaving Boroondara on 3/139 off 58 overs. On the second day Luke (3/83) and Adam D'Addazio (4/44) took the ball and proceeded to skittle Boroondara's middle and lower order as we rolled them for 189, man of the match Adam taking 3/13 off 9 overs on the second day. Mindful of the poor start to our chase last year, Ben Banks-Smith and Tom Bach saw off the crucial new ball period before Ben fell in the 10th over, as the score was 1/14. Luke Javernik (47) strode to the middle in his first senior grand final and despite some nervous moments, played a crucial hand as he combined with Tom (64) to take the game from Boroondara with a patient 105 run stand before the two fell in quick succession. With plenty of overs in hand, there was a complication as we sought to complete the chase before the end of day two. Losing a few wickets in the process, the time was 5:57pm when Tom Casha struck his third ball past the bowler for four to secure our fourth MacGibbon Shield.

It was an amazing season that featured six centuries and three 5-wicket hauls from our players including breakthrough centuries to Sam Fairbrother, Ben Banks-Smith (who brought up his century with a 6 off the last

ball of the innings against AYC off 53 balls!) and Tom Casha, while Tom Bach (104*) also played a faultless innings as he brought up his century against AYC as we batted for a declaration.

We saw the emergence of a superstar as Sam moved from a gifted talent to becoming a devastating match winner, hitting 623 runs and taking 17 wickets on his way to his maiden Basil Finnigan Medal, Club Champion and Batting Award. It was a joy to behold and bodes well for the future.

We welcomed newcomers to the side with Simon Hearn, Luke Javernik, Alex Brebner-Griffin and Matt Thomas all making strong impressions as the next generation looks promising.

Congratulations to all involved in the First XI on an outstanding season. We have now won the most MacGibbon Shields and are the premier synthetic club in the ECA.

Thanks to the committee, the wives, girlfriends and parents of the players and the rest of the supporters who make this club great. The next challenge: the three-peat!

<u>T20</u>

Our Kookaburra T20 Cup campaign featured highs and lows. We kicked off our campaign with a heart breaking two run loss to Glen Iris, a match that featured an astonishing 10 run outs. Beau Coyle was the pick of the bowlers with 2/20 while Dan launched a sparkling burst of 35 off 16 balls to begin our run chase.

Our next matches against Trinity and St Kevins at Swinburne became the Sam Fairbrother Show as he struck 46 off 21 balls and 75 off 53 balls as we enjoyed comprehensive victories, passing Trinity in just six overs.

Our round of 16 match, featured a superb partnership between Steve O'Connell and Tom Bach as they endured a torrid turf pitch and put on 80 in 9 overs to set up a defendable score of 131. Our bowlers did a great job to restrict Boronia to 8/119 in reply.

Our campaign ended in the quarter finals against eventual champion Heathmont who convincingly outplayed us as we lost by 62 runs. To continue to progress in this competition, our batsmen will need to better adjust to the demands that come from playing on turf.

Second XI Report

This season was a successful one for the 2nd XI, which might seem unusual to say, since we didn't make the finals. But we won 8 games & lost 5 to finish equal on points with 4th place, missing out by 0.04%. This win / loss record would have seen the team playing finals in every other grade of the ECA. Looking back on the year there are many games when we could have gained a better percentage, but our best chance of getting into the finals came in rounds 11 & 13 when we came within a whisker of winning outright in both games.

The season started off on an extremely cold & rainy day for round 1, which saw most games abandoned. We played through the adverse weather & it was really pleasing to have many club members come down & watch us beat BUC who were to go on to play in the grand final. It was in this game that Matt Thomas made 103 runs. This was an extremely mature knock from Matty & I had great pleasure in giving him a giant hug when he made his ton. Not content with just making a ton, he took 4 wickets the next week. Matty is a very talented cricketer & I hope he gets kicked out of the Singapore army so he can keep playing cricket at STC.

From there the season ebbed & flowed with the team winning games, but also dropping some which we could have won. Our last game before Christmas was an outstanding team performance with us beating Knox Churches by 211 runs. After Christmas we were to lose just one more game, but other results just wouldn't go our way.

In round 11 we played Deepdene, & what looked like a standard win at tea on the 2nd day turned into an exhilarating run chase for outright points after we bowled them out for 74 in their 2nd innings. We had 5 overs to make 64 runs. Scoring 11 & 12 runs in the first 2 overs was a great start but we fell just short.

Coming into the last round against our friends Trinity we knew we had to either make up a lot of percentage or win outright. After some explosive batting by Mick O'Connell & Liam Sierakowski we left ourselves with 36 overs to bowl Trinity out in their 2nd innings. They were 5 down after 14 overs but we could only manage to get them 8 wickets down. Beau Coyle finished with amazing match figures of 9/96. The effort of the guys right to the very end was amazing & showed me that, had we made finals, we would have been a force to reckon with.

I am very proud to have won the premiership in the first XI. When I applied for the captaincy of the 2's I asked that if I was needed in the 1's then I would play there. I had hoped to spend all season in the 2's but it wasn't to be. I captained the 2's for over half their games & enjoyed it immensely. I hope to captain the team again next year.

I would like to thank the 5 other players who took the captaincy while I was in the 1's. Thanks Brad Craine, Ben Banks Smith, Mick O'Connell, Beau Coyle & Dan Sharpe. It is great to have so many leaders at our club. I would especially like to thank Crainey & Sharpey for helping me while I was learning the captaining caper.

The batting award was won by Matt Williams with 315 runs @ 26.25. I watched him during pre season training & was very impressed with the amount of time he has to play the ball. Having given up bowling due to a back injury he had set himself for a big year with the bat & I locked him in as my number 3 bat for the year

The bowling award was won by Matt Doran with 22 wickets @ 21.23. Like Willo he played all bar 1 game in the 2's this year & opened the bowling on most occasions. This is very impressive for a 17 year old. His in-swinger to the right hander is a devastating delivery & the extra pace he gained this year made him very difficult to face. The most important piece of advice I gave him this year was "You can't stare down a batsman if you look like One Direction". Matty also took out the team champion & I know he has a great future for STC.

The youngsters performed wonderfully this year but the elder statesmen can't be forgotten either. Jack Krohn, Peter Lynch & Chris Giannakopoulos all played crucial innings during the season. They prove that age doesn't dictate your cricketing ability.

I'd like to thank Dan Burt and the committee for the tremendous work they do throughout the year. I'd like to thank Brad Craine & the selectors for getting 55 cricketers on the park each week. I'd like to thank Schwatta for

the awesome lunches this year. Finally I'd like to thank my family. Lisa, Luke & Tara let me keep doing what I do well. Playing cricket & sitting down watching other people play cricket.

Third XI Report

The Third XI had a season that encapsulated all that is good about STC. Young players were exposed to senior cricket, the club was, at all times represented with distinction, Schwatta smoked plenty of Darts, oh and we won a flag!

New players joined the team in droves with two in particular proving to be invaluable in chasing the club's 19th premiership flag. Gamini Jayasinghe and Dinuka Jayasuriya were highly accomplishe middle order batsmen, brilliant fielders and in Dinuka's case, game changing bowlers. Juniors also played many games and continued what will surely be long and successful careers playing senior cricket for the greatest cricket club in Australia, Dom Hando proved he has the safest hands in C grade taking 9 catches and dropping none in only 7 games. Xavier Wigg played his first game in the 3s and acquitted himself brilliantly and James and Tom Briggs also played in a crushing win over Mazenod when they took the field with the father Richard. It is this new blood and vetting of the juniors that allows this club to be as successful as it has over the last 46 years.

The 2012-13 year for the People's XI was a truly remarkable one. The side did not lose a game. In fact, it tied one game after a momentous batting collapse against Trinity Willison but with the exception of that it was a flawless season.

The year was punctuated by many brilliant individual performances. Two unbeaten tons by Peter Lynch not only saw him take out the team's batting average it also saw him finishing 3rd in the association batting averages. Pete carried his bat in both innings! One of the most entertaining innings I've ever had the pleasure to watch was David Spithill's 111* against Trinity Willison. The team was looking a little shaky at the 30 over mark but that's when Moose got settled, having only walked to the crease in the 27th over Moose brought up his century in just 11 overs, at one stage taking 37 runs off a single over! Dinuka Jayasuriya's match saving 100 against Ashwood after being 7/140 aided the team to finish with 9/336. The 4 centuries were also supported by two 5 wicket hauls for our bowlers; Raj Ravindranath's 5/35 against East Doncaster ruined any chance they had of chasing down 184 on a small ground and Peter Morrison's gutsy 5/34 was taken on one leg in the semi final against some quality batting from Ashwood.

The team's season performances were also of high note, on 3 occasions the team scored over 250 runs in one day games. In the 5 two-day games after Christmas, including the semi final and the grand final the side averaged a score of 334 runs per innings, incredible numbers given the fact that 4 of those 5 games were against eventual finalists Ashwood (twice), Heathmont, East Doncaster and Mazenod. The team won 4 games by over 100 runs and in one memorable encounter against Mazenod posted an impressive 273 run victory.

The finals proved to be the greatest challenge of the season however, so they should. So, the semi final involved playing Ashwood at The Field of Dreams. It is this game that would prove to be our toughest game of the season. 2 separate batting collapses had us at 3 for 28 and 7 for 140 respectively. Only Tom Sandilands showed what finals batting was about with his stoic 69 batting at number 4. At this stage, Dinuka Jayasuriya, was on 27 and was joined at the crease by Andrew Krohn. The two of them went on to compile a 116 run, game changing partnership. It only ended when Dinuka was dismissed for his first ever century, finishing with exactly 100. But it didn't end there, Schwatta more than doubled the amount of runs he scored that season when he made 30, by the end of the day's play we were 9/ 336 and Andrew Krohn was on 75 not out. When it came to Ashwood's batting we knew two things, they had 3 very good batsmen and after that they have a bunch of dead set bunnies.

Unfortunately 2 of these 3 good bats played very well. When Ashwood for 3/180 I was understandably worried. But then, one of the gutsiest things I have seen on a cricket field took place. After pinging his Hamstring in his opening spell Peter Morrison put his hand up to come back on and bowl what would be the spell that would change the game, a spell that was bowled on one leg. Morrow took 4 of the next 6 wickets, ripping through Ashwood's middle order and any hope they had of taking the chocolates. They lost 7 for 50 in the end, Morrow finished with the figures of 5 for 34 and it was a grand final berth for us.

The Grand final was a little less nerve wracking than the semi final. A slow but steady start with the bat meant although we weren't piling on the runs, we weren't losing wickets quickly either. Peter Morrison had just joined Dinuka at the crease when the rain came. We took an early tea, and in the 20 overs that were bowled after tea Morrow, Dinuka and Liam Sierakowski put the game into our hands. They made 101 runs in just 20 overs after tea, taking full advantage of the wet ball. It meant we finished our innings on an easily defendable 211, Dinuka once again top scoring with 50 and Sirra finishing with 42. So we took the field knowing we had the talent to bowl our Heathmont for well less than our score and we did. An amazing run out by Dinuka, sharp catching from Lynchy in the slips and an amazing clutch catch by Sirra when he had to run and get under a skied ball from one of their better bats. We had to work harder for it that we though with their final pair putting on 50 runs but a comical run out meant Heathmont were bowled out for 154 and we were premiers.

It was my first year in a captaincy role and I relished the extra responsibility that came with this position. My speeches when wickets were taken have been described as "tear inducing", "inspirational" and "a massive death". Only two tosses were lost for the entire season, but most importantly, in conjunction with winning games great fun was had by all who played in The People's XI. It was an amazing year that could not have ended any better, for the club or for the team itself, I hope to remain captain next year also and look forward to the challenges that a being in a higher grade bring.

Fourth XI Report

The 2012/2013 season can be classified as a period of ups and downs for a side that struggled for consistency and continuity. When the Fourth XI performed to its potential it threatened any side it came across, whilst at times matches proved an overwhelming challenge. Throughout the season we struggled with the weekly ins and outs and this is a concept that we will need to improve on moving forward.

The draw threw up some challenges early in the season with our first seven games played against eventual top four sides. Although we battled hard early in the season our first win wouldn't come until Round Four against Burnley. The rounds before Christmas posed the biggest selection headaches with our Round Five game versus Clifton Hill highlighting our lack of depth. Four players debuted for STC on that occasion.

Our post-Christmas performances were solid and provided us with the opportunity to make the final four. Often Harry bowled without luck but finished with twelve wickets at 35.42 wand best bowling of 4/41.

Xavier Wigg took the next step this season performing under pressure a number of times with the bat averaging 32.00 and a highest score of 61. Aside from being a solid wicket keeper Xavier has developed into a handy partnership breaking bowler. As we look to the future we must continue developing our junior cricketers by providing an environment where they can flourish. The Fourth XI is definitely providing an exceptional breeding ground for STC's next champions.

All seasons have their highlights but it would be remiss not to mention the century makers from the Fourth XI in 2012/2013. Fabian D'Addazzio scored an outstanding 134 versus Deepdene in our Round Eight clash whilst Daniel Burt excited the crowds with his 124 against East Ivanhoe at Nettleton Park. There were many other solid performers during the course of the season including Stirling Rowe and Damien Vardy at the top of the order and Chris Wigg with a number of dominant performances with the bat. As mentioned Harry Douglas was a standout with the ball along with Daniel Burt and Peter Morrison when available for the Fourth XI.

I would like to thank the committee and all players who took the field for the Fourth XI for their support during my first year as captain. It was a privilege to captain a side of such a great club and I would like to thank in particular the assistance that was provided by Stirling Rowe, Daniel Burt and Gary Douglas. The job of captain is made much easier with the support of such passionate and dedicated STC members. I and the Fourth XI look forward to the challenges of next season and urge all players to make themselves available for a solid pre-season as we make a push for finals qualification in 2013/2014.
