First XI

At the time of writing, captain Sam "Fairmother" Fairbrother is playing cricket in England where apparently they don't have computers so he asked me to report on the season past.

The season started poorly with a loss to Boroondara in a grand final replay in round one. This match included the club debut of Sanjay "Stabbed with a knife" Ct and also the First XI debut of Matthew "Dora the Explora" Doran. Playing their first games for the First XI later in the year were Paddy "Spud" Brandner & Nick "The Hunter" Cropley. This first round loss hurt. We don't like losing to Boroondara.

An epic win in the last over of a one-dayer against Edinburgh in round 2 preceded comfortable wins in the next 3 rounds. Credit also to Luke for 4/20 from 20 overs in the first innings. In round 8 we had an unexpected loss to Wycliff. However the 70 run partnership for the 8th wicket between Stephen "Shteeeben" O'Connell and Matt "Singapore Noodles" Thomas was a highlight.

After Christmas we had to keep winning to secure a top 2 spot on the ladder. We smashed Boroondara, passing their 72 runs in 15 overs. A horrible loss to Clifton Hill made us question our premiership capabilities. But then we smashed Manningham where Tom Bach made a superb ton, ably assisted by Dan "I didn't hit it" O'Connell's blistering 83 whilst injured.

The last round produced another get out of jail game, against East Ivanhoe where Ben "Gummy" Banks-Smith & Adam "Removalist" D'addazio sealed the win for the last wicket. During this game Rohan's first 9 overs were maidens. We finished the season 2nd on the ladder, equal points we Boroondara on top with 10 wins and 3 losses.

During the season we competed in the T20 competition. We won all 4 of our group matches. Against Edinburgh, Steve & Tom put on 127 for the 3rd wicket with Steve finishing on 98 not out. Back to the 2 day version of cricket, we had a Semi Final against Deepdene. They never quite got going in their innings & made a below par 183. Luke "Sticks" Javernik, Steve & Fairy contributed well for us to pass them in just 45 overs. On to the Grand Final to play Boroondara for the third time in a row.

We finally won a toss but were shortly in trouble at 4/20 after 16 overs. Tom & Luke batted with extreme patience & waited for the bad balls which eventually came. They put on 90 together before Luke was controversially given out caught behind. The score was 110 & we needed to make some quick runs as overs were running out. Enter Ben Banks-Smith. He smashed them all over the park. He made 50 runs from 58 balls. His aggression rubbed off on Tom who increased his scoring rate. Towards the end of the innings they had all 9 fielders on the boundary. At the start of the last over Tom was on 93. He brought up his ton from the second last ball of the innings with a huge 6 over mid wicket. This was an innings of unsurpassed quality. the over before tea to have them 3/94 from 41 overs. From there, we grinded them into the ground. Runs stopped & wickets were regular. We got them out for 175 in the 76th over. What an amazing feeling. The huge sea of red crowd rushed onto the field to celebrate.

Congratulations to the Second XI for winning the Burt Shield. It was very special for the club to see our top two teams winning flags on adjacent grounds.

Congratulations to Fairy for captaining a premiership in his first year as captain. He did an outstanding job leading a team of players most of whom are older than he is. Tom Bach also displayed great leadership & advise in his role as vice-captain.

It was pleasing to see improvement in so many players this year. Russell "Flog Features" Flint stepped up to be a very reliable bowler. Don't believe him if he says he has an outswinger. Tom Bach had a tremendous season making 2 tons & over 500 runs. Luke confirmed his status as the best bowler in the competition with many long, fast & accurate spells. It was a great joy to see him break Basil Finnigan's record to become the leading wicket taker in STC history.

I'd like to thank Peter Lynch and his selection committee for their great work in getting 5 teams of players on the park each week. Enough can't be said of the tremendous amount of time & effort put in by my President Michael O'Connell & the committee. Without their hard work we wouldn't be able to play for this great club & win flags. Finally, thanks to all our families who support us during the long cricket season.

Second XI Report

Matty 'the destroyer' Doran ran through their top order on the second day of play taking 6/43 and propelling himself to man of the match in a winning grand Final knocking them over for 74. It was fantastic to see the 18 year old stand up and take 14 wickets across three days of play. He looks to be one of the young guns of STC and don't be surprised to see him play a fair chunk of the season in the ones next year.

We had some fantastic individual performances during the year with Matt Williams making over 50 runs in his first four innings. Dan O'Connell tonned up against Blackburn United while Andrew Krohn took 7/25 in the same match.

I'd like to thank Michael O'Connell as well as those also on committee for their hard efforts during the year.

Fourth XI Report

The key wicket came when opener Alex Grainger was given out LBW for 53 in the last over before tea with the score at 3-94.

The wickets continued to fall after the break as D'As- toli (2-46) and Rohan Worthy (4-27) guided South Camber- well home.

Disappointed Boroondara captain Robbie Ross was at a loss to explain why his side had been unable to win a Macgibbon Shield despite having played in the past four grand finals.

"I used to think it was in- experience so we threw a couple of older guys in this year and figured that would help but we just couldn't get it done in the end," he said.
