1XI

I was unsure at the start of this year. Last year at presentation night I slyly lampooned Sam Fairbrother for not absolutely believing we would win our third premiership in a row. Now I admit that at the start of this season I was thinking the same way he had thought: This would be a 'concept' year, a chance to blood some younger players, think towards the future, set ourselves up for another 3peat in a few years' time – and several other clichés that suggest that one shouldn't get their hopes up about the year to come. These thoughts were validated on our first day of the season when we were hit for 313 at Hays Paddock. I was buoyed that Paddy Brandner happened to take 8 wickets that game and that Ben Banks-Smith made runs; so buoyed I decided that I'd hardly bowl Paddy for the rest of the year and must have told Ben to stop making runs despite always batting well and looking solid.

Leaning on more clichés, we developed the team motto of never surrender. Every ball is a new and unique contest regardless of what has passed or what might come. Our first few games unearthed some talent. Russel Flint, who made his first hundred in the 1st XI and had his best year with STC, became an opening batter, something he did for the rest of the year. Tom Casha built on his explosive and much improved batting to become an important one-day bowler, who, despite taking 4/10 from 8 overs against St Paul's, decided that, from week to week he would need to constantly change his bowling action, run-up, his pace and his outlook on bowling. Andrew Krohn bowled his loopy left arm tweakers with the arrogance and aggression of a 56kg ginger. Andrew unerringly backed himself in battles that he would inevitably win and by doing so, changed several games in our favour. This commitment to process was epitomised by Matt Williams in the semi final when his commitment to 'the process' of hitting the winning runs saw him swing as hard as he could at 4 balls in a row before he finally executed 'the process' and edged the ball over the keeper for 4.

In the Grand Final, the onslaught brought by our pace bowlers Adam D'Addazio and Luke D'Astoli and our medium pace bowler Russ el Flint, backed up by good fielding left Edinburgh directionless. Needing only 87 runs to pass their first innings total Tom Casha hit a six to pass their score and Ben Banks-Smith played another clutch grand final innings. Adam D'Adazio took three wickets in Edinburgh's second innings to consolidate his man of the match performance as we dismissed them for 154. Paddy Brandner led guided our second innings, opening the batting with astounding maturity as he had in the first innings. Paddy hit the winning handing us an outright victory by 7 wickets.

We won our fourth premiership in a row.

The point of difference between our team and other 1st XIs is our enjoyment. While our opposition is busy getting nervous, we're busy having fun. This is due to who we are playing with and who we are playing for. After the Grand Final I thanked all of the players for this, and I'd like to thank you all again – everyone who played in the team, that includes Matthew Doran, Richard MacDonald and Angus Hamilton.

I'd like to thank Stephen O'Connell for being my vice captain. Your, and Luke's, gentle, even-handed advice was always wise and supportive. Your assistance off-field was also more than I expected or could have hoped for.

Thanks also to the committee – running our club well is an enormous task and hopefully we can start sharing it with some new people in the next couple of years. We are grateful for the commitment, support and sacrifice that you make so that we can play, enjoy and succeed together.

I am no longer unsure, or at least a lot less so. Next year we will be in an even stronger, more enviable position to do this all over again. Because we realise that nothing holds us back.
